

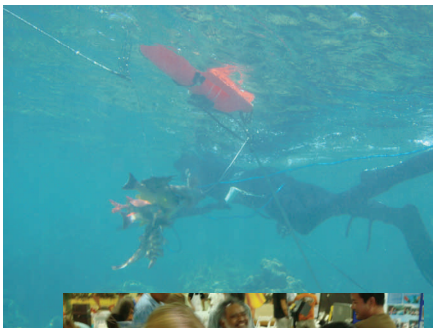


Hawaii Community Fishery Workshop Series
