Workshops will feature interactive booths on the following topics:

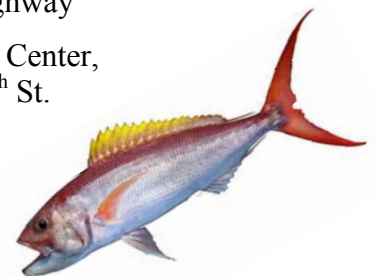
- New State Annual “BF” vessel registration
