
## **INSHORE FISHING VESSELS**


Have you heard ... "It takes a village"? Well, catching the Atule in season does indeed "take a village." Atule come around up to twice a year.

Department of Marine and Wildlife Reasources Fishing License for Commercial Fishing

There are no catch limitations on traditional and subsistence fishing with the exception of endangered or protected species.
