Potential Project Descriptions

• Annual Report Development

The Intern would be responsible for the compilation and development of annual report modules including, but not limited to, non-commercial fishing, protected species, habitat, human dimensions, indigenous fishing communities/TEK, ecosystem indicators, catch and effort data.

• EFH Review Assistance

The Intern would be responsible for components of current EFH reviews taking place or proposed for review. Components could include literature reviews, impacts analysis, data compilation, etc.

• Data Analysis Projects

The Council has many projects that collect data but need assistance in analyzing data and creating databases. These projects would need to have data and data sharing agreements in-hand prior to the start of the internship

• Community Management Plan Projects

The Intern would assist the staff in developing the community management plans where necessary by developing documents, generating data, providing reviews, etc.

• Fishery Ecosystem Plan Amendment support

The intern would be responsible for assisting staff in the development of FEP amendment analysis, document writing, formatting, and literature review.
